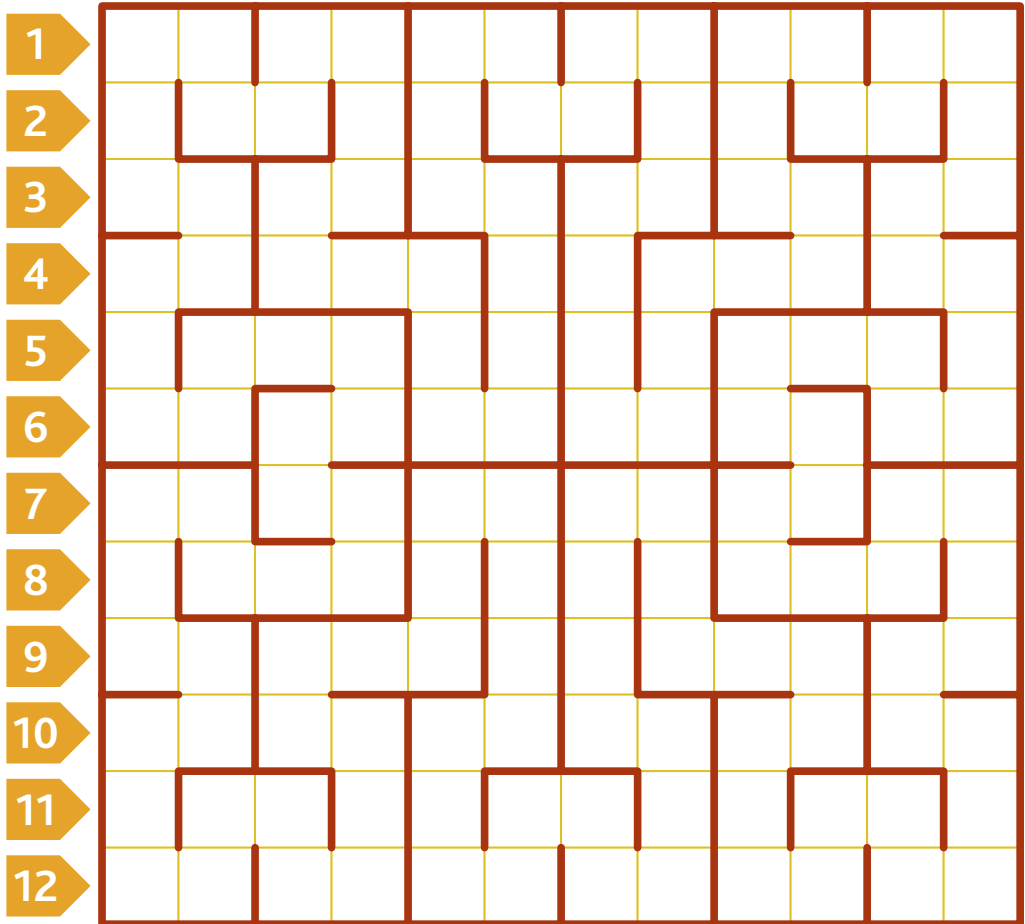


Conga Line

They form one long path that winds its way around the grid between the heavy lines, ending in the box beneath the starting box like a conga line. Use both sets of clues to find your way around.
