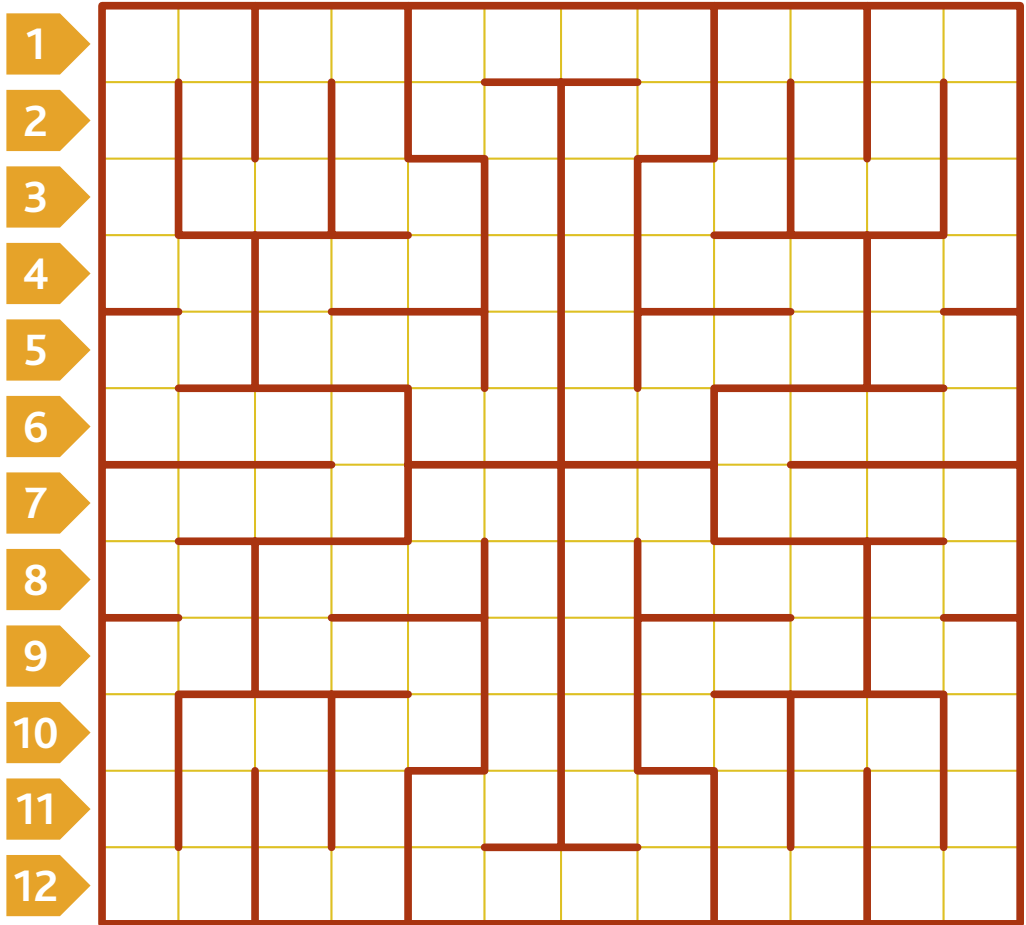


# Labyrinth

Use both sets of clues to find your way through the maze.
